Dear friends,



In 2022 we were thrilled to expand our reach to include students studying through the Theological Education for Emerging Ministries (TEEM) program. LEADERS GUIDING LEADERS



When Fund for Leaders (FFL) scholars Jeanette Perrault and Jill Disbro entered seminary, they were both certain of their calls to ministry, but they didn't know yet where the Holy Spirit would lead them.

At first Jeanette assumed that she would follow a traditional route through theological education and into congregational ministry. As she neared the end of her studies at Wartburg Theological Seminary, though, she started to feel that something was missing. She took a class called "Reading and Leading in Context," which included the topic of administration as ministry.

This persuaded her that she could use her planning and organizational skills in her call rather than set them aside along with her previous career. "I'd never been more seen in seminary," she says. Shortly after that, she learned that Wartburg was searching for a director of admissions. As she recalls, "It was like these blinders fell off of my eyes and I was opened to these new possibilities."

Jill enrolled in Pacific Lutheran Theological Seminary (PLTS) after spending a year in Mexico through the Young Adults in Global Mission program. As

she went through seminary, she says, she remained “pretty open” to wherever the Holy Spirit might lead her after graduation. She saw different ways to lead within the church, and she liked knowing that she had options. She felt particularly drawn to working with people in discernment, which led her to apply for the director of admissions job at PLTS.

In their current roles Jeanette and Jill speak with other potential seminary students about the different ways they can lead. Jill says she has appreciated meeting different kinds of students. As access to seminary has expanded, she has seen people come in straight out of undergrad, others who have established careers and families, and still others who are retired and looking for a new way to serve the church they’ve been part of for their whole lives. She meets people who want to do advocacy, camp ministry, chaplaincy and more. “At PLTS one of the things that our leadership is focused on is how we can expand seminary education beyond just people who are going to become clergy.” They are looking for different ways to make people in congregations feel “empowered to serve where they weren’t always before.”

Jeanette’s and Jill’s work has also deepened their appreciation for ELCA Fund for Leaders — and for the generosity of donors. Jeanette remembers

her awe when she received her own scholarship and her great relief that her seminary education wouldn’t drive her into debt. Now she sees the impact FFL scholarships have on others across the ELCA. When the school year began, Wartburg hosted a gathering for the 13 students who had received FFL scholarships. “I just felt their excitement and how affirmed they were,” Jeanette says. “Even though they didn’t know what they were maybe getting themselves into completely, they knew they had the support of a group of people who said, ‘Yes, I want to invest in them,’ not only financially but as leaders in the church.”

Both Jeanette and Jill have gained a deeper understanding of how church leaders are formed, which they will carry with them on their own leadership journeys. They know that seminary education is only one part of the process. Jeanette’s message to people in churches and communities is: “You can see your people in a way that one person in a seminary can’t. If we are in need of more leaders in the church, it is all of our responsibilities to identify them and lift them up. We don’t do this work alone.”

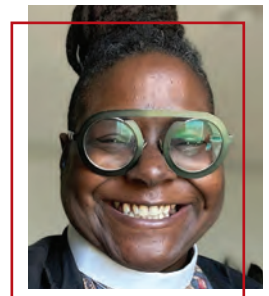

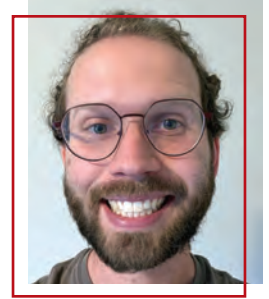

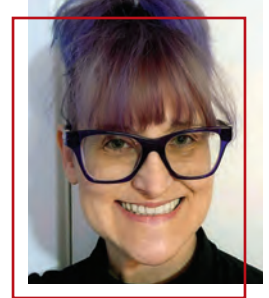

THEOLOGICAL EDUCATION FOR EMERGING MINISTRIES FUND FOR LEADERS SCHOLARSHIP

As part of our commitment to support a diverse group of students, Fund for Leaders is again allocating 10% of available (i.e. nonrestricted) funds to TEEM students. 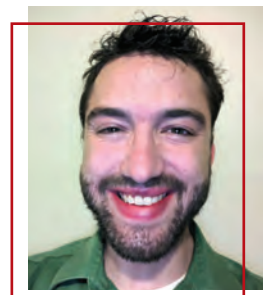

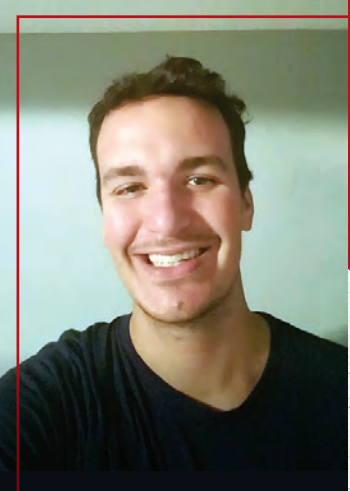
