Nominations due May 1

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Students must be:

- Enrolled at an ELCA seminary
- Registered for classes, internship or CPE
- Enrolled in MDiv (deacon or pastor),
 MA (deacon)or PhD degree program OR Enrolled in TEEM, TEIL certificate programs
- Pursuing rostered ministry in the ELCA (word and service or word and sacrament)
- Considered by the synod to be in good standing and moving forward in the ELCA Candidacy Process

Examples of eligible students:

- TEEM, TEIL candidates
- Students receiving any other type of Fund for Leaders scholarship
- MDiv graduates from any seminary fulfilling Lutheran learning and formation candidacy requirements at an ELCA seminary (aka "Lutheran year").
- TEEM graduates returning to seminary and entering a MDiv or MA degree program

SELECTION PROCESS

- Synods may make their selection decisions however they wish (e.g., award funds based on merit or need). Scholarships can be awarded equally or in differing amounts.
- Synod scholarships are awarded for one year.
- All synod awards are meant to be additive to other assistance a student may already be receiving and can be used for non-tuition expenses associated with their studies. *Note: scholarship funds used to cover costs beyond tuition, books, and fees (e.g., room and board, insurance, etc.) will count as taxable income.*
- If there are no qualified students from your synod, or if your synod chooses not to award a scholarship for a particular academic year, the ELCA Fund for Leaders may reallocate scholarship funds to ensure that ELCA candidates from across all synods are being provided with as much assistance as possible.
