



ADVENT TREE

Whether your tree is in your church's gathering space or at home, ornaments serve as a reminder of your giving. Decorate a tree with ornaments that represent ELCA Good Gifts as well as your congregation's fundraising goal. 


Mark your calendars — plan for Lent 2022!





Pair the activities with an ELCA Good Gifts fundraiser to support ELCA World Hunger's animal projects.






STICKERS


