## Reformation anniversary commemoration planned for Washington, D.C.

On Tuesday, Oct. 31, ELCA Presiding Bishop Elizabeth Eaton will co-host a commemoration of the 500th anniversary of the Reformation. The event, which will include a worship service and speakers, will be held at Lutheran Church of the Reformation on Capitol Hill in Washington, D.C. Eaton will be joined by co-hosts ELCA Vice President Bill Home, Bishop Bill Gaffigan of the Indiana-Kentucky Synod and Bishop Richard Graham of the Metropolitan Washington, D.C. Synod.

The event, which will meet under the theme "Looking Back and Called Forward," will be available online via livestream for all to watch.

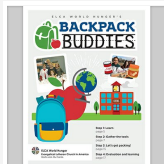

UPDATES on *Always Being Made New: The Campaign for the ELCA*

With the support of ELCA members and congregations like you, we are committed to establishing the Evangelical Lutheran Church Africa Mission in South Sudan. With a goal of \$1.5 million by 2019, the project includes building a new Lutheran community center and health clinic in Juba, training mission leaders, conducting outreach programs and, ultimately, raising up an ethnically and culturally diverse church. In addition, based on an evangelism strategy found effective in other African nations, the Lutheran Center hopes to offer information technology and English as a second language courses, contributing to youth employment.
