Social Responsibility Approaches

Portfolio Screening:

Negative or avoidance – exclude companies conducting specific activities.

Positive or proactive – select companies with positive environmental, social or governance (ESG) records. Portfolio Screening <u>Shareholder Advocacy</u> – improve company performance on environmental, social and governance concerns by engaging companies through shareholder resolutions and dialogues.

Shareholder Advocacy Active Ownership

<u>Social Impact Investing</u> – capital invested in underserved communities focused on achieving certain social or environmental returns.

Proxy Voting <u>Proxy Voting</u> – voting of company's annual meeting resolutions to ensure investor voices are heard.







