Where might I continue this journey?

- We encourage you to consider using a few of the questions below with leaders from your congregation to start a discussion about what your next steps might be.

Questions for Reflection and Discussion:

- Where does your passion for Jesus come from?
- Where does your passion for evangelism come from?
- What bible story comes to mind when you think about why it is important to reach out to those who might be "outside" the religious institutions?
- Why is evangelism important to you? Why is it important for your congregation?
- Who could you invite into deeper conversation around how we share our faith?
- What might be one next step you could take to help your congregation build relationships with those who aren't a part of the congregation in the community?
- How will you share this with your pastor and other members of the congregation?
- What tools/resources do you have? What do you still need?
- What goals does your congregation have for evangelism?
- How will you achieve them?
- How will you measure the success or failure?
- How will you celebrate successes?
- How will you learn from failure?

(Evangelism is not an exact science. Every congregation and community is unique. There will be successes and there will be failures. Try and learn!)
