Year C focuses on the Gospel of Luke. The semi-continuous Old Testament readings are of prophetic proclamation chosen in chronological order and highlighting Jeremiah. The second, New Testament, readings are chosen mainly from Galatians, Colossians, 1 and 2 Timothy and 2 Thessalonians.

The Semi-continuous series provides Old Testament readings and psalms that, while not

as explicitly connected to the gospels, explore many of the books and stories not covered by the Complementary series. Citations for the semicontinuous series may be found in the back of *Evangelical Lutheran Worship*.
