SUSTAINABILITY	A commitment to relationships of accountability that steward God’s gifts for the present and future.

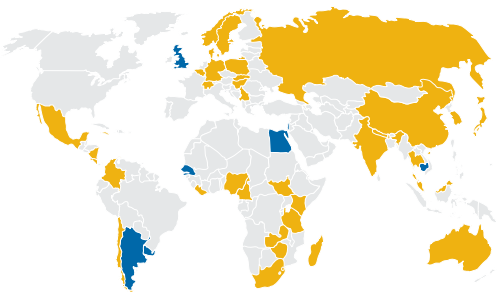

INTERNATIONAL WOMEN LEADERS

The International Women Leaders (IWL) program supports young women leaders from the ELCA's global companion churches by offering full-tuition scholarships in partnership with ELCA colleges and universities in the United States. In the 2024-2025 school year, there are **16 scholars** at **11 schools**. Like missionaries, IWL scholars share their skills and passions as part of our global community of faith, both in the United States and with their home communities. IWL is part of the International Leaders Program, which provides leadership experiences through scholarship grants and leadership development programming to individuals around the world.

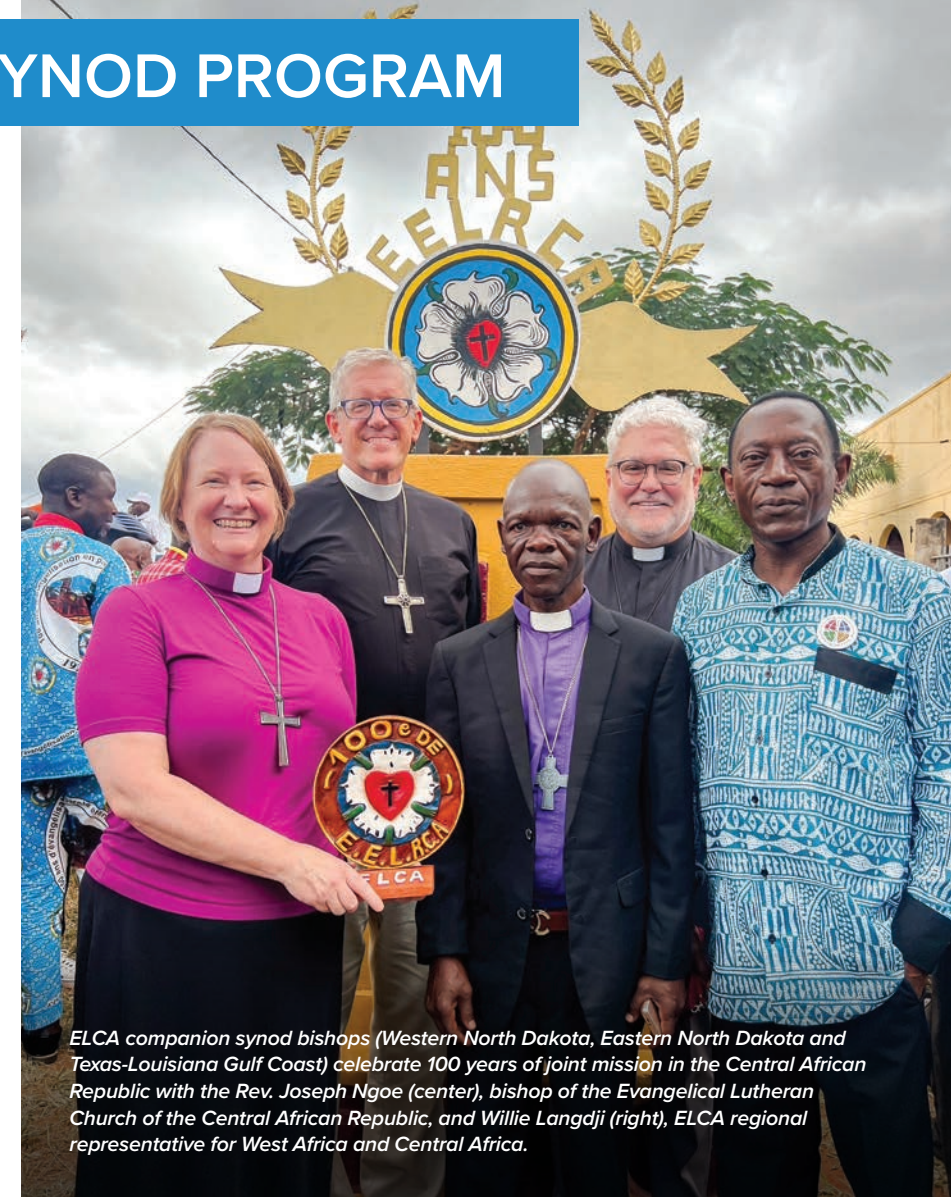
ELCA COMPANION SYNOD PROGRAM

Companion synod relationships of the ELCA connect Lutheran churches throughout the world with ELCA synods and congregations. These relationships are concrete expressions of the ELCA's communion and fellowship with the more than 140 member churches of the Lutheran World Federation. Each of the 65 ELCA synods has at least one international church companion, and many have additional relationships, for a total of more than 120 companion synod relationships.

These relationships are rooted in accompaniment, which promotes the values of mutuality, inclusivity, vulnerability, empowerment and sustainability. Through the program, companion churches and ELCA synods nurture and strengthen one another for life and ministry through prayer, study, communication, exchange of visitors and sharing of resources.

We are a church that believes God is calling us into the world — together. Companion church relationships enrich and deepen our ministries by exposing us to global challenges and perspectives as we seek to work with one another to build up the body of Christ in the world.

The companion synod program is supported by the churchwide organization through the following strategic priorities:

COMMUNICATION — Network meetings and regular communication in coordination with the area desk directors, regional representatives and mission personnel.

DELEGATIONS — Small groups traveling to visit companions are supported and encouraged by ELCA staff in the region.

CONSULTATIONS — All companions who relate to a region, country or church spend several days engaging in conversation, learning together and revisiting relational agreements.

EDUCATION — Continuing development and distribution of resources in the areas of accompaniment and cultural competency.

GLOBAL GIFTS — Facilitating the transfer of funds to companion churches and projects through the ELCA Gift Processing Center.

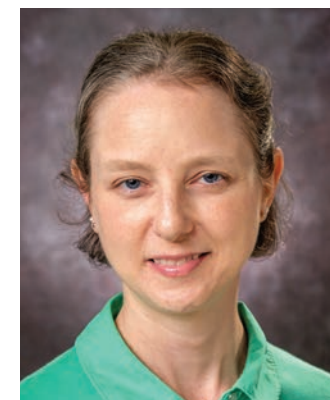

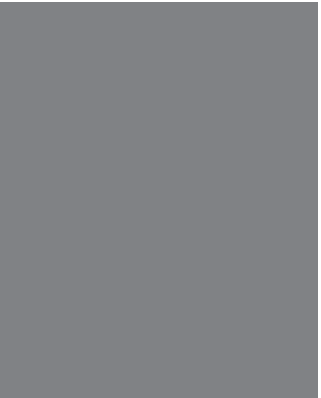

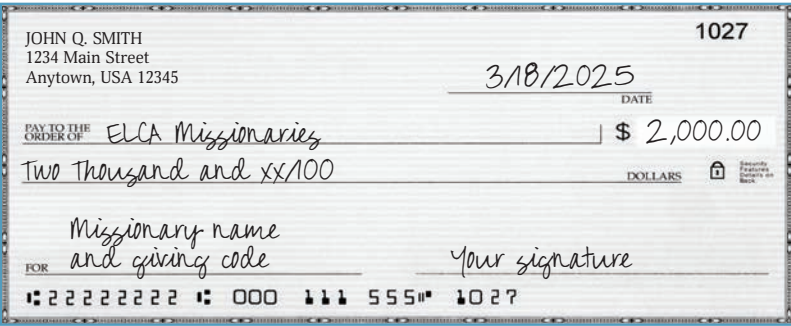
